

After School Activities Extended Day Program

Countryside School offers its own after-school care program, called the Extended Day Program, each school day from 3:00 to 5:45 p.m. Our Extended Day Program includes children from all our grade levels K-8, and is supervised by two adults. The social climate is that of a neighborhood play group, with some time set aside for homework or quiet time. Snacks are provided to the children. Our current average enrollment is 25 students per day.

The Extended Day Program is comprised of 2 consecutive sessions. Session 1, which includes a snack, runs from 3:00-4:00 pm and costs \$7 per day. Session 2 runs from 4:00-5:45 pm and costs \$4 per day. Students attending both sessions everyday pay a discounted rate of \$9 per day if prepaid monthly. Students who need extended day accommodation after participating in after school clubs or sports attend only session 2.

On the days that school is dismissed at Noon, Extended Day students bring their own lunch. The cost for these days is double the cost of the individual enrollment options, e.g., \$18.00 for Full-time Extended Day.

Sports

Athletic teams, which practice twice a week, are offered for grades 4-8.

Girls volleyball (junior varsity and varsity): late August - end of October

Co-ed soccer (boys and girls on same team): late August – end of October

Girls basketball (junior varsity and varsity): early November-late January

Boys basketball (two teams): late October-early February

Band - for students in grades 4-8.

Book Club - open to students in grades K-8

Chess Club - open to students in grades K-8.
